Hoping this letter finds you and yours safe and healthy. You are receiving this letter because your turn for the COVID -19 vaccine is here. On March 15, 2021, eligibility for a vaccine begins for those who have a developmental or other severe high-risk disability. While vaccine supply is limited, you can start looking for appointments to get vaccinated in your area. If you work with an agency providing support, we have asked them to help with finding an appointment. Your case manager and our web site also have information. If you have questions about whether the vaccine is right for you, please reach out to your doctor.

This is an exciting next step in being able to resume more activities with others. Vaccination doesn't mean we will be able to stop wearing masks or social distancing right away but we believe it will mean many more people stay healthy. On the back of this page is a personalized letter for the vaccine site. It verifies that you meet the criteria for vaccination as a person served by the regional center and at risk. **Bring this letter to your vaccine appointment to verify your eligibility.**
