Step-by-Step Guide to CEIP Certification for EDUCATION / LEARNING PROFESSIONALS

ELIGIBILITY



3 YEARS of professional service or full time equivalent experience in the field of education/learning



1000 HOURS of documented delivery of learning services incorporating horses



120 HOURS EDUCATION AND TRAINING IN EQUINE INTERACTION

40 HOURS: Direct facilitation training for equine interaction services

40 HOURS: Attendance at equine interaction services conference, workshop, method training (or similar)

40 HOURS: Formal training in equine behavior/horsemanship (course, clinic, or similar)

A bachelor's degree (or higher) is required. Coaching or other facilitation professionals with a Bachelor's degree belong in this category. A pathway option is available if you do not hold a bachelor's degree.

Documentation: Resume/CV

Attach a copy of your Bachelor's degree

The 1000 hours of equine interaction services may overlap with the 3 years of experience in your profession.

Documentation: Application Form

Direct facilitation training means that you were actively engaged in equine interaction facilitation practice in a learning setting and received feedback.

Documentation: Application Form
Attach evidence of attendance for all hours.

EXAMINATION



After your application has been reviewed and you have been found eligible, examination is provided in two parts: through an open book test and through a portfolio review. Examination is completed during one of two yearly examination windows.
