Students Engaged in Ethical Donations (SEED) is a youth-led philanthropic initiative for Black high school or college students who are interested in creating lasting change and giving back to the community. Through collaboration and mentorship with the giving circle Real Engagement through Active Philanthropy (REAP), members have the chance to grow into the role of philanthropist and proactive community member.

Grow.

Using their collective resources, SEED members fund small, student-led organizations throughout the valley. Additionally, members devote their time to a service committee of their choice, while also volunteering out in the community. Along the way, students receive mentorship from Black community leaders who share their wealth of professional and philanthropic knowledge.

Create change.

Potential members should be:

- Between 16 and 21 years old
- Currently enrolled in High School, GED Program, College, or Trade School

Membership requirements include:

- Serving 250 hours annually on a REAP committee (Finance, Development, Marketing, Grants, or Events)
- Annual contribution of \$80
