## ***Best Practices***

We've had enough 'Stay at Home' time with the COVID-19 pandemic. We're ready for 'hands-on-a-horse' time again at our Triangle Farms Horseshows ... have a great show and be safe!!

Please observe the following *Best Practices* at the Triangle Farms Shows: Face Masks, Social Distancing and Hand Washing/Sanitizing!!

Social Distancing of 6' must be maintained at the office, in the barns, in the arena, at the gates, in the schooling areas and in all areas on the grounds.

Hang with your family & Barn Family as you've been together before the show but respect the Social Distancing of 6'.

Have Hand Sanitizers at your barn, in your ring tack box & in your pocket. Triangle Farms to provide Hand Sanitizers at the office window, at the gates, in the restrooms & at the Hospitality Table.

Face Masks are required, except when mounted. Triangle Farms Face Masks are available at the Show Office window.

Triangle Farms to provide bottles of water at the gates & juice bottles instead of coffee at Morning Hospitality. Morning Hospitality & Surprise Hospitality to be pre-wrapped for 'Grab and Go'.

Enter online at [www.horseshowsonline.com](http://www.horseshowsonline.com) before you come to the show ... but if you need to enter at the show, complete your entry and work with Sheri at the office window. We need extra-organization on the part of our barns. Only staff are allowed in the show office.

All Add/Scratches must be done by the close of the office the day before showing. Add/Scratch boxes will be outside the office window ... drop one copy of your Add/Scratch form in the Office Box & one copy in the Gate Box.

Splits must be completed with the Show Office by 2pm on Saturday.
