This week in our reading through the Scriptures we come to the Prophet Daniel. His stories are familiar to all who has spent any time in Sunday School or serious Bible study of any kind. As we consider the "Writing on the Wall" account it is my hope that we see some very relevant applications for our individual lives and for our nation in these very trying times.

There are two passages that we come to a little later in the book that I would call your attention to. First in Daniel 9:13 it says; "Just as it is written in the Law of Moses, all this disaster has come on us, yet we have not sought the favor of the Lord our God by turning from our sins and giving attention to your truth."

Wow! While they were watching everything come unglued they refused to repent. How sad is that? To recognize that you are out of bounds, to see the devastating cost, and to keep right on doing what you are doing. Most people would call that insane. But there is another passage that gives us encouragement. Dan. 9:18 it says; "Give ear, our God, and hear; open your eyes and see the desolation of the city that bears your Name. We do not make requests of you because we are righteous, but because of your great mercy."

Do you hear that? We can call out to God, not because we deserve to be heard but because of His great mercy and His desire to be in a restored relationship with us. That is why He sent Jesus into the world. That is the gospel message.

We all need a wake-up call from time to time. This is one of those times!
