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HOMELESS SHELTER – INDIVIDUALS

1-800-Homeless assists with the placement of individuals into shelter services when available. If a person is homeless (on the street and not doubled up), 1-800-Homeless can assist with completing an application for the Permanent Supportive Housing Waitlist. As available, the program also assists with rapid rehousing and homeless prevention funds.

HOMELESS SHELTER – FAMILIES

MA DHCD Shelter (Department of Housing and Community Development) and EA (Emergency Assistance) for families with minor children. Families are not eligible for shelter if experienced an at-fault eviction and they cannot show a reduction in income. If this is the case, they will need to seek resources from their own network (family and friends) 866-584-0653
