Scripture Memorization:

Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us.

– Ephesians 3:20 (ESV)

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Starter: What are you looking forward to most in 2021?**
- 2. Did anything stand out to you or do you have any questions from the passage/sermon on Sunday?**
{Maybe ask for a verse they highlighted, or a note they took.}
- 3. Can you say the vision statement?**
{For our community and world to be filled with all the fullness of God.}
- 4. Can you say the mission statement?**
{To be a Christ centered community driven by the joy of the Gospel to make disciples who make disciples.}

Read Ephesians 3:1-6

5. How does this passage lead us to thankfulness?

{There's so much here: Through Jesus, even Gentiles are able to fellowship with God.

Men like Paul suffered (he mentions his imprisonment here) so that we could hear the Gospel. We live in a generation (unlike other generations) in which the mystery of Christ has been revealed. It can be overwhelming to consider the implications of verse 6. That we are heirs, and the same body, and partakers of the promise. }

Read Ephesians 3:7-13

6. How does verse 7-13 give us hope that God can use us?

{-God calls us through his grace and power, not by our strength.

-God uses the "least of the saints," to preach his unsearchable riches.

-God's plan is to use the church to make himself known.

-We can have boldness and access to Jesus through our faith.}

7. What are the "unsearchable riches of Christ"?

{This is really an opportunity to explore the beauty of Jesus. What makes Jesus wonderful and glorious? The unsearchable riches of Christ is who he is and how he expresses himself. So have your group describe who he is and how he expresses himself.}

Read Ephesians 3:14-21

8. What do these verses teach us about God?

{There's a ton to pull from in these verses. Specifically, we learn that he hears our prayers and that he created us and that he wants to dwell with us. Generally, we learn that he made everything for his glory and it's only by his strength that we enjoy his glory.}

9. What steps can your Life Group take to help your community and world be filled with all the fullness of Christ?

{This is a time for brainstorming. How can your Life Group be on mission together?

I hope you get a lot of good answers, but like Paul, make sure that prayer and love are mentioned as key tools.}
