

RESOLUTION: 2020-1

TOWN OF MONROE
CLERK/TREASURER APPOINTMENT

The Town Board of the Town of Monroe, Green County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That pursuant to Wis.Stat.60.30(1e) (a), the office of the Clerk/Treasurer shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the town board.

The term for the appointed position shall be set by the town board, but may not exceed 3 years per SS 60.30(1) The town board may re-appoint the officers for additional terms. However, removal by the town board during a given term of office may only be for "cause" as defined under SS 17.001 and required by SS 60.30 (1e) a.

This ordinance is subject to approval by the town electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the Town Board to be held on November 3, 2020. The referendum question shall be:

“Should the office of Clerk/Treasurer, in the Town of Monroe, change from an elected position to an appointed position that would be appointed by the Town of Monroe Board?”

The salary of the appointed position shall be set by the town board and may not be reduced during the term of office.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its town board passage, notice after passage per SS 60.80 and also its referendum approval by the town electors as required by SS 60.30(1e)(b).
