THE NEED



72,000 domestic violence 911 calls annually in the Las Vegas Valley



26 domestic violence arrests every day



10 to 20 new court cases daily at the District Attorney's Office



Top 10 most dangerous places for women being murdered by men

THE SOLUTION

PROJECT SAFE 417 (PS417) is designed to bridge the gap between when police respond to a call to the time when a victim/survivor receives crisis services, advocacy, and support.



THE PROCESS

01

Officers Respond

Las Vegas Metropolitan Police (LVMPD) officers respond to the scene of domestic violence 911 call

02

SafeNest Deployed

Officers call the SafeNest hotline and remain on scene

03

Victim Supported

Advocates arrive and provide services, safety planning, and support

04

Support Provided

If needed, SafeNest hotline staff are available to support on-site team

05

Advocates/ Officers Leave

Officers and advocates leave together; SafeNest advocates never remain without officers present

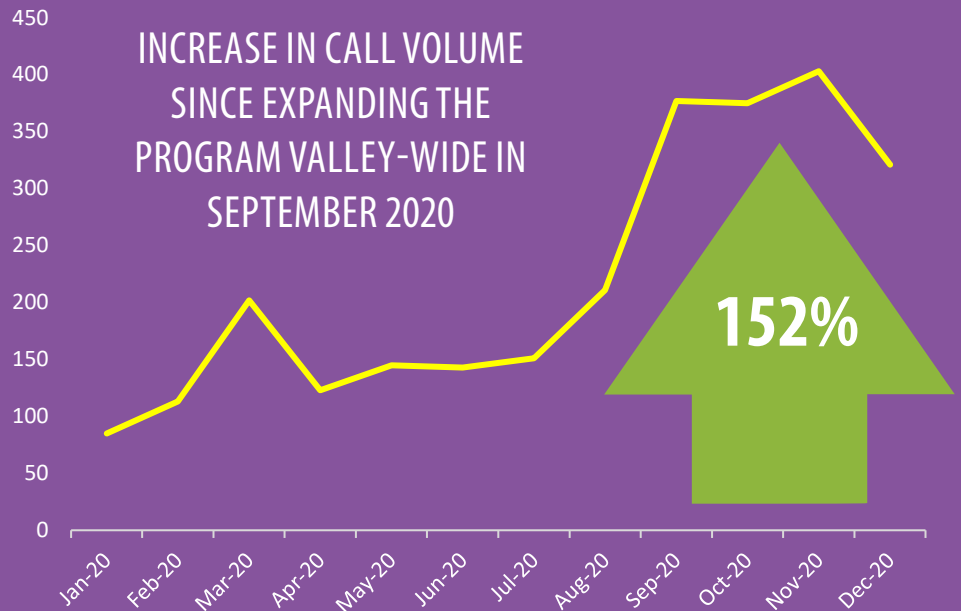
