The purpose of a compensatory program is to supplement the regular or basic educational program with intensive and accelerated instruction. These programs include supplemental interventions for students who; are on a Title I campus, have failed STAAR, are at-risk of dropping out of school, are homeless, are migrant, are Bilingual/ESL and/or are pregnant/parenting. The scholarship will be awarded during the ACET Spring Conference and provides \$1,000 to the recipient **to be used within a year from the student's graduation date**. The scholarship will be paid directly to an accredited postsecondary university, college, community/junior college, technical, or vocational school, not directly to the scholarship recipient.
