The IMPACT Projects in California: IMPACT LA & the Bay Area Rural Justice Collaborative

## Support for Remote Clinics Programming

In 2020, the impact of COVID-19 necessitated a re-design of our mobile pop-up in-person legal clinics model. We were very fortunate to be able to work with our legal services, community and private pro bono partners to quickly pivot to remote clinics through both the IMPACT projects we coordinate, in addition to our other projects.

Amidst this global crisis, OneJustice has provided legal assistance to families throughout the state by partnering with pro bono attorneys and legal aid providers; distributed our “virtual” toolkits to legal advocates across the nation who are helping families survive this pandemic; and trained, mentored, and consulted with legal aid organizations that are facing extraordinary demands for their services. We are working to develop new virtual pro bono clinics focused on eviction defense and homelessness prevention to respond to the growing need. Our work is helping families facing eviction or unemployment issues, survivors of domestic violence, immigrant communities, and many more low-income households across our state at a time when demand is higher than ever.

As a support center, our clinics are not only a way to serve clients through pro bono support, they also serve as an important way to test pilot clinics and service models. Through our experiences, we were able to record our learnings, and after testing and evaluation, create a remote clinics toolkit. The toolkit, which we have been sharing with the sector, includes pro bono workflow, project management tools, security best practices, data collection strategies and sample templates for client surveys and more. We are continuing to develop and build out our toolkit as we expand our partnerships and pilot different types of clinics.

## More about our IMPACT Projects:

**The Bay Area Rural Justice Collaborative** mobilizes pro bono attorneys to bring free legal help to rural and isolated communities located outside the Bay Area’s metropolitan centers. Volunteers from law firms and in-house legal departments staff free pop-up legal clinics. Launched in May 2013, the Rural Justice Collaborative first focused on serving south Santa Clara, coastal San Mateo, and Napa counties, and has since expanded to serve east Contra Costa, El Dorado, Sonoma, and San Joaquin counties. We are currently coordinating Rural Justice Collaborative clinics remotely, with a focus on reaching immigrants in need of legal services.

**IMPACT LA** brings wraparound legal services to survivors of domestic violence through free pop-up legal clinics, in partnership with domestic violence service providers and shelters in Southern California. Pro bono volunteers from law firms and corporate in-house legal departments provide free legal services through limited scope legal clinics in substantive areas necessary for survivors to gain stability, including immigration, housing and family law. Launched in November 2013 in partnership with the Jenesse Center in Los Angeles, IMPACT LA has developed partnerships with other providers, including WTLC and Peace over Violence, and expanded services to communities through Los Angeles and Orange counties. We are currently coordinating IMPACT LA clinics remotely, in close consultation with our partners to be responsive to the shifting needs of survivors.
