



# Appalachian Ice Arena Facility Rules and Guidelines

**Skaters and spectators assume all risks and danger of personal injury arising from or related to admission to Appalachian Ski Mtn., including but not limited to –being injured by falling, ice skates, ice skaters, spectators or objects in and around the rink and buildings.**

- Appalachian Ski Mtn. is not responsible for injuries or property damage. Skaters skate at their own risk.

- Skaters must purchase tickets for each session and affix them to clothes for visible inspection at any time.

- Helmets are highly recommended. The decision to wear a helmet or other safety equipment normally associated with ice skating is the responsibility of the skater and not the operator.

- Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian sign a waiver for them.

- No one is permitted on ice without skates.

- Children 5 years and younger must be under direct supervision of an adult or guardian on the ice.

- No one is allowed on ice during resurfacing.

- While on ice, skaters must move in direction indicated by skating staff or crowd flow.

- While on ice, skaters are not allowed to carry children or items such as handbags, cameras, etc.

- Please use caution entering and exiting the ice. Exits must be kept clear at all times.

- **DIGGING ON SKATING SURFACE WITH TOE PICK OF SKATE IS CAUSE FOR EJECTION FROM FACILITY.**

- Beginner skaters should skate along the side railing, or use Skate Aids.

- **NEVER LEAVE SKATE AIDS UNATTENDED ON THE ICE. .**

- While on the ice, keep moving. Stopping abruptly may cause an accident or obstruction for other skaters.

- Skating across traffic or cutting in front of other skaters is prohibited.

- Skating in a manner that endangers or interferes with other skaters' safety or pleasure is prohibited.

- No eating, drinking or smoking on the ice.

- While on the ice, no talking on cellphones and no use of portable electronic devices, ie., cameras, ipads, etc.

- No more than two skaters may join hands while skating. Chain skating/Conga lines are not permitted.

- No tag, racing, weaving or games of any kind are permitted on or off ice.

- No running, horseplay or unruly behavior.

- No Hockey sticks or puck play allowed on ice.

- No dogs or pets of any kind permitted on ice.

- Throwing snowballs or objects of any kind is prohibited.

- Socks must be worn at all times when using rental skates.

- When not on ice, skates must be on rubber surfaces.

- Management is not responsible for personal items stolen or left within or near rink or building.

- The management reserves the right to revoke a ticket/pass without refund at any time for misconduct or nuisance caused by the ticket holder.

## Please Note

- Report all accidents to a staff member immediately.
- Ice conditions may change over the course of the session and/or day due to temperature, weather, and skater traffic.
- Beware of soft spots, rough edges, water puddles or other hazards.
- Always skate according to prevailing conditions and Ice Arena Staff instructions.
