Rules for Float Judging

Judging is done as your unit passes through the designated judging area. A panel of judges will be looking for areas of perfection (listed below). Your application must be marked that you would like to be judged to qualify for the cash prizes. The total scores from each area will be tallied, and the final score will determine the winners. Awards will be announced that night at the Festival Grounds at 9:30 pm.

Floats must be a decorated platform towed behind a truck. Decorated vehicles do not qualify as floats and cannot have the application fee waived or be judged in the float category.

Judging Criteria: 2021 theme TBA

Theme, Originality, Music, Creativity of Materials, Presentation, and Use of People

Float Cash Prizes are Awarded for:

Best Interpretation of Parade Theme \$150 -and- Judges' Choice \$150

Awards will also be given for First and Second place Drill Teams.

Rules for Parade

- Absolutely nothing is to be thrown from vehicles or floats.
- IF PERMITTED per COVID regulations at the time of the parade, parade entry participants may walk along the curb to hand out treats. It will be the responsibility of the person completing the parade application to ensure that no participants throw items. Violators will be asked to leave the parade immediately.
- Absolutely no stopping for any reason, unless directed by police or other parade official(s).
- Walking/performance units must keep pace with other entrants or you may be asked to leave the parade.
- Sports teams are encouraged to ride on a truck or trailer.
- Special requests will be considered on an individual basis. Please email any special requests to info@milfordmiamitownship.com.
- The use of sirens is strictly prohibited.
- Absolutely no alcoholic beverages will be permitted on vehicles or floats.

Violators or any of the rules above may be asked to leave the parade.

Music is appreciated!

1. The Frontier Days Committee reserves the right to determine the appropriateness of any applicant or entry and to grant them parade space.
2. The Frontier Days Committee reserves the right to determine the entry level of each participant and the appropriate charge.
3. The Frontier Days Committee reserves the right to place any and all parade participants, before and during the parade.
4. All participants are expected to police their line-up area for garbage before the start of the parade.

A completed application must be submitted no later than May 7, 2021, and fee received no later than May 10, 2021.

A parade position number will be assigned & mailed to you in mid-May along with other information re: your staging area and time to arrive. If your entry is not accepted, you will be notified and your fee will be returned.

Your parade number must be displayed on the left front of your entry (this includes marching units).
