Our church runs a variety of ministries that offer food to the hungry, provide for the homeless, support recovering addicts, and serve students at a downtown school. Our church decided to expand our mission of serving our community and the world by also caring for God's creation. Our church chose to install a 100kW system, and we were able to save 15% on our initial installation with Collective Sun's proprietary funding model.
