As an Arizona taxpayer, you can re-direct your state income taxes to benefit a specific student or school of your choice by making a tax credit contribution to a school tuition organization, like Yuma's Education Scholarship Fund For Kids, Inc. In 2014 the maximum credit for married couples is \$2,106 and \$1,053 for single taxpayers, or your state tax liability, whichever is less. Not only is this a charitable donation for federal tax purposes, since YES Fund for Kids is a 501c(3) organization, this is a dollar-for-dollar tax credit that directly reduces the amount you must pay to the state of Arizona. The best part is that you are able to control where some of your tax dollars go while helping with [Jane and John's] tuition! We would like to invite you to take the credit for our children.
