**Clients must present a Minnesota-issued I.D. and proof of one of the following:**

- Food Stamps
- Medicaid
- Free or Reduced Lunch Program (Public Schools)
- Social Security Disability (SSD)
- Minnesota Care (MNCare, UCare) or Medical Assistance (MA)
- Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)
- HUD Section 8 Housing
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Major VA Disability
- Temporary Assistance for Need Families (TANF) formerly AFDC
- Unemployment
- Your most recent income tax return demonstrating \$40,000 or less in annual household income.

**Service fees** (due at drop-off, cash only): Male Cat or Rabbit \$40, Female Cat or Rabbit Spay \$50, Dog under 50 pounds \$60, Dog over 50 pounds \$70. Other services, including vaccinations, are available at the time of surgery for additional charges.
