2. AFTER REVIEWING THE LITERATURE RESULTS, PICK ONE OF THE ARTICLES YOU REVIEWED AND CLICK ON THE PoC CME LINK DISPLAYED ALONG WITH THE LITERATURE LINK ON OUR **ONE CLICK** SEARCH ENGINE.

3. COMPLETE THE PoC CME FORM (ALL THE ★ FIELDS) AND SUBMIT

4. YOU WILL RECEIVE A COPY OF YOUR COMPLETED FORM IN YOUR EMAIL AS WILL THE CME PROGRAM DEPARTMENT. YOU WILL HAVE EARNED .5 AMA PRA CATEGORY 1™ CREDITS IN POINT OF CARE.
