Course Description:

Students will act as either producers and or studio musicians to develop 7-10 songs at a rate of one song per every 2 weeks for a possible virtual concert presentation on December 16, 2020. Finished songs will be posted at youtube.com and also at the www.akjazzworkshop.org website for students to view. Producers will act as the leaders and oversee all aspects of the song development process including: assigning parts and providing reference tracks with a click track to the class musicians to sync up recording their parts to, collecting the recorded mp3 audio & mp4 video tracks from the musicians, assembling, mixing the recorded tracks in their DAW, giving the musicians feedback about their recorded tracks, & posting the finished songs online. For the studio musicians there will be weekly assignments including: practicing, recording, and submitting your audio and video part to the songs each week to the producer, weekly production meeting attendance, which will be recorded on Zoom Meetings, for on demand viewing. Meetings will be hosted by John Damberg & Nick Petumenos and will feature presentations by professional guest artists TBA in many aspects of the music production industry.

Rules:

1. Students should plan to attend all sessions. Students will pay for all class sessions at the time of registration. Please call or tell me well in advance when you will be absent.
2. Students agree to work to fulfill all the class requirements, goals, practice their music, and do the homework assignments

Requirements:

Students must be able to read music at a beginning to intermediate level, know the notes on their instruments, play the major scales, want to learn how to produce music by using technology to collaborate with other musicians on the internet, and be able to attend the majority of the class sessions. No Credit will be given for missed classes. There must be a minimum of 5 students signed up for the class to be held.
