

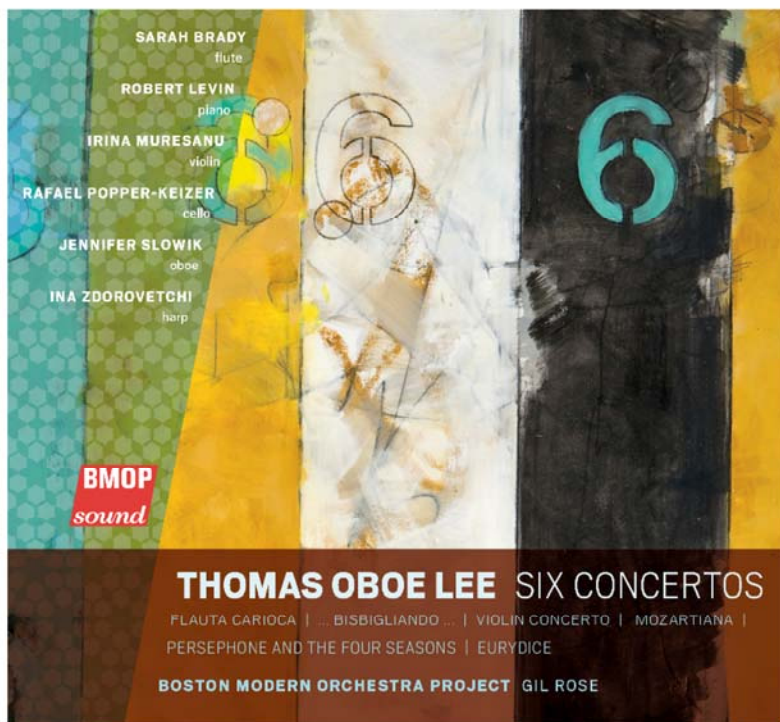

The 25th entry from BMOP/sound brings together a collection of concertos by Thomas Oboe Lee. A man of many influences, Lee was raised in Shanghai, spent ten years in Brazil, and moved to the United States at the age of 21. This eclectic musical upbringing brought forth a fusion of bossa nova, jazz, and traditional sounds from each culture. Featuring the talents of Sarah Brady (flute), Robert Levin (piano), Irina Muresanu (violin), Rafael Popper-Keizer (cello), Jennifer Slowik (oboe), and Ina Zdorovetchi (harp), *Six Concertos* marks a triumphant collaboration between BMOP and Thomas Oboe Lee's musical dexterity.
