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**Notes:**

This year because of Covid-19 and the unknown of when in person meetings will begin again, the North and Central American Region (NCAR) has created a series of professionally videotaped demonstrations that can be shown virtually on Zoom. These videos feature high ranking sensei from Japan and the U.S., and represent a variety of ikebana schools as indicated on this program schedule. To share the expense of creating the video library available to us, we have purchased a "subscription" for the 09/01/2020 - 08/31/2021 time frame, and feel fortunate to have virtual "guest" demonstrators within I.I. to give us different perspectives from their experiences. In the past we have depended on the talents of our chapter teachers and mentors for our monthly demonstrations, but it appears nearly impossible to rely on having in person demonstrations this calendar year. The two possible exceptions, although remote, are for the 04/28/2021 and 05/26/2021 meetings (see Note #2). This year we have added two general meetings (07/28/2021 and 08/25/2021) during our normal summer break in order to continue member ikebana experiences and make better use of our 12 month purchased video subscription.
2. The 04/28 and 05/26/2021 meetings will be done either pre-recorded or live by our teacher members and will be based on universal themes that will translate to all of our schools. We encourage attendees to do homework after the presentations by using one of the themes to create an arrangement, and then send photos to Ginger Truschke so they can be shared with the membership in the future.
