**Information shared at December 12, 2019 information meeting (CCC Osterville)**

Bridgewater requirements

1. Register at Bridgewater State University as a “non-degree” student (until admitted/accepted into Program)
2. Participants will need to register and pass Communication & Literacy MTEL (to apply for M.Ed. Program)
3. Participants looking to complete the Master’s Program must file an application for admission to the BSU Program
  - a. Required will be: 3 reference contacts; Transcripts; Personal Statement
  - b. Once matriculated, will be assigned a BSU advisor
4. If looking to do the M.Ed. Program will need an Intro to SPED course and Psych (or equivalent developmental course)
  - a. This requirement can be waived through BSU process if you have already taken
    - i. You will need this listed on transcript & a description and/or syllabus of course
5. Individual needs can be reviewed with BSU for further guidance
  - a. E.g. those already holding a teaching license in another area; those only completing M.Ed., etc.

CCC cohort

- Projected to begin end of January 2020 with 2 pre-requisite courses offered
  - SPED 509 & SPED 510
- Courses will likely be 4:00 or 4:30 - 7:00 or 7:30 and held at 418 Bumps River Road, Osterville (CCC offices)
- Two courses each semester will be planned - Tentative schedule:

- Class days will be dependent on the professor teaching the course
  - Each course would be 1 day/week
  - Courses would not run on Fridays
- Once the initial spring 2020 dates are decided, payment will be due to Cape Cod Collaborative prior to the start of the first scheduled class: \$600 district members; \$100 Cape Cod Collaborative staff
  - Participants will then receive information for registration codes/process to complete for BSU

- Classes may be one of the following: Online or face-to-face or hybrid
- CCC staff will also have a 1-page application for the cohort
