Neighborhood Clean-Up Days

All single-family residential customers receive 3 neighborhood clean-up days per year at no additional charge. Find your next scheduled neighborhood clean-up day at:

www.sanramonrecycles.com/cleanup/.

THE CLEAN-UP PROGRAM INCLUDES:

Collection of up to 3 cubic yards (3' x 3' x 9') of materials and up to 2 large bulky items (60-200 lbs. each) per set out. This includes collection of clean undamaged reusable items that are set apart from other items. The reusable items will be sent to a sorting/donation facility. (no receipts given for reusable items.)

PLEASE NOTE: Due to current COVID restrictions, the ACI of San Ramon Reuse Recovery Program is subject to the variability of markets and the reuse organization acceptance policies and procedures. Reuse collection may be limited at times. Thank you for your patience and understanding.

HELP US PROVIDE SAFE AND EFFICIENT SERVICE.

- Place items within 3 feet of the curb by 6:00 a.m. on your scheduled neighborhood clean-up day.
- Do not block the street or sidewalk.
- Do not set items out more than 24-hours in advance.
- No single item over 200 lbs.
- A fee is charged when materials volume exceeds 3 cubic yards.
- Extra individual clean-ups can be arranged for a fee.
- Mark your reusable items with 'REUSE'.*

EXTRA GARBAGE BAG TAGS are used for overflow garbage. Extra material will be collected when pre-paid tags are affixed to the trash bag(s). Call us to purchase tags (\$10.31 each) or to arrange for additional service.



EXTRA YARD TRIMMINGS BAGS can be purchased and placed next to your **Organics** cart on collection day. Yard trimmings set out in these bags will be composted. (Only ACI of San Ramon bags are accepted. Cost is \$10.31 per bag. Contact us to purchase).

Collection Rates Increase 1.18% on January 1, 2021

Free Curbside Collection

Household Batteries: In a zipper-lock style bag on top of (*not inside*) your **Recyclables** cart. Please tape terminals on 9 volt batteries. *No automotive, lithium ion or nicad batteries allowed, these are treated as Hazardous Waste.*



Used Motor Oil & Cooking Oil:

In separate (**oils cannot be mixed**) 1-gallon, or smaller, sealed screw-top containers. Used oil filters in a sealed zipper-lock style bag. Place next to (*not inside*) your **Recyclables** cart. Oil jugs and oil filter bags may be requested from ACI of San Ramon. *No other automotive liquids accepted.*

Have extra? Contain occasional extra recyclables in paper bags or cardboard boxes and place next to your **Recyclables** cart for collection. Excess cardboard needs to be flattened, cut to pieces no larger than 2 ft by 3 ft, and stacked next to your **Recyclables** cart.

Maintain Smoke Detectors and Carbon Monoxide Alarms



- Test existing detectors/alarms.
- Install new batteries and properly recycle the old ones. (*see "Free Curbside Collection" above*)
- Remove non-working detectors/alarms and install new ones.
- Dispose of non-working detectors/alarms responsibly.
 - Many manufacturers offer a mail-in program for smoke detectors/alarms. Refer to the product label, user's manual, or warranty for manufacturer's instructions.
 - Bring your non-working detectors/alarms to Contra Costa County's Household Hazardous Waste drop-off facility. **(800) 646-1431** or **www.sanramon.ca.gov/hhw** for more info.



You Can Minimize Water Pollution

Keep the creeks, rivers, the Delta and the Bay clean and healthy. Follow these tips:

- If you change your own oil, contain and recycle used oil and filters properly. (*see "Free Curbside Collection" at left*)
- Place litter in the correct collection cart.
- Prevent leaves in storm drains, place them in your green **organics** cart.
- Avoid using fertilizers and pesticides, especially if rain is forecast.
