



## CAS Risk Assessment Form

During CAS experiences, participants may be exposed to risks and it is important that these risks are identified and assessed. This form is to be completed before a student undertakes a CAS experience that poses some sort of risk.

In the event of an emergency:

- Have an emergency number to call
- Ensure your supervisor has emergency contact details

Record a method of dealing with any potential risks that you may face while participating in this experience:

<b>Potential Hazards/Risks</b>	<b>Treatment/Avoidance</b>
E.g. Falling from a ladder while building	Ensure someone is holding the ladder at all times and check the stability of ladder and suitability for the task. Suggest alternative tasks if considered dangerous.
