

CLCS Online School

Online or LIFEPAAC® courses may not be taken in lieu of a current scheduled teacher-instructed course (exceptions: *provided there is not a conflict, see #1 below or the courses are taken in advance of a standard teacher-taught course, see #2 below*).

CLCS uses Ignitia® and LIFEPAAC® (from Alpha Omega Publishers) to supply the course material for the Online School. All online courses will receive appropriate credit toward fulfilling WV high school credits for graduation. Online courses will be distinguished from traditionally taught courses on the student transcripts. Students desiring to take online courses must complete the appropriate application, pay registration fee of \$175, and pay for courses in advance. Seniors must be enrolled as a full time student to be eligible for participation in the Commencement as well as the Senior trip. **Seniors whose transcript is comprised of 33% online courses will receive a general diploma regardless of the online courses taken.**

The cost of each course is:

- For a **current full time student enrolled at CLCS**
 - One credit equals 10 units \$300/course/credit
 - Half credit equals 5 units or less \$175/course/half credit
- For a **part time student enrolled at CLCS** \$350/course
- LIFEPAAC set \$150/course

Students may take online courses for the following **reasons**:

1. An unavoidable schedule conflict with the current master schedule (there is no charge for courses that are in conflict with the master schedule for **current full time students**)
2. As an enhancement for extra credits, or advanced credits (\$300/course in addition to regular tuition)
3. As a replacement for either missed courses or failed courses (\$300/course in addition to regular tuition)
4. As a part time student (online courses are not eligible for the requirement to participate in extra-curricular)
5. As a home school/bound student desiring to receive a transcript from an accredited school.
