



Financial Assistance Information

The School Board has established procedures and policies for applying for financial assistance. Those procedures are outlined below:

1. The Bible asks us to be faithful stewards of His resources (I Cor 4:2). Discernment of the attitude of the applicant toward the School is based on Luke 12:48, *“For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.”* You will be asked about a commitment to provide some kind of service activity for the School. This will not be a requirement, but it is highly recommended, and is in accordance with the last phrase of Luke 12:48 (see underlined section)
2. An application must be acquired from the school office, filled out completely, and returned by March 31 of the re-enrollment month. **Please note: applications for financial aid needs to be re-applied for each year.**
3. The School Board will consider the application and discuss the legitimacy of the need. **The information in the application will be treated confidentially.**
4. The School Board reserves the right to ask for verification of income and expenses. (All personal information will be kept with strict confidence).
5. The amount of assistance was determined at the April School Board meeting for all enrollments. The next consideration for financial grant will not be until the spring of the succeeding school year.
