WHAT WOULD THE MILLAGE ACCOMPLISH?

The Michigan Transportation Fund (MTF; derived from gas taxes and vehicle registration fees) pays for road repairs and improvements. It was recently raised in January 2017, but still does not provide enough funding to improve local roads. Over time, materials have become more and more expensive, while MTF funding has remained about the same over the last decade. As a result, many of our roads have fallen into disrepair and road work in Lenawee County has been primarily focused on essential maintenance activities, such as patching pot holes, plowing snow, etc., instead of completing local road improvement and construction projects.

Lenawee County Road Commission (LCRC) can handle construction projects in a given season up to \$600,000 for our township. If passed, the millage request would generate as estimated \$386,520 the first year, and when combined with other township, and LCRC funds would provide over \$500,000 for road repair.

The sole purpose of money generated from the millage will be for the reconstruction, resurfacing, repairing, and improvement of roads within Raisin Charter Township.

HOW MUCH WILL THE MILLAGE ISSUE COST ME?

The amount the 1.50 mills will cost each taxpayer is a function of the value of your property and the millage rate. The table below shows the cost of the road millage for several different property values.

Property Value	Taxable Value	Annual Cost
\$75,000.00	\$37,500.00	\$56.25
\$100,000.00	\$50,000.00	\$75.00
\$150,000.00	\$75,000.00	\$112.50
\$200,000.00	\$100,000.00	\$150.00

RAISIN CHARTER TOWNSHIP ROAD MILLAGE PROPOSAL

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property in the Charter Township of Raisin, County of Lenawee, Michigan, be increased by 1.50 mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value), for a period of four (4) years, 2020 to 2023, inclusive, as new additional millage to provide funds for road improvement purposes? It is estimated that 1.50 mills would raise approximately \$386,520 when first levied in 2020.
