Essential Job Functions:

- Conduct comprehensive psychological and psychoeducational evaluations for children ages 2 through 16, who present with symptoms of autism, developmental disabilities, ADHD, behavioral difficulties, etc.
- Generate in-depth reports that provide a complete picture of patient functioning and demonstrates thorough analysis of data, including standardized test results, clinical interviews, observation, and any other relevant information. These reports should be generated in a timely manner for a prescheduled feedback.
- Develop and present an extensive list of positive, constructive and concrete recommendations (based on behavior principals) to assist patients with a diagnosis.

- Conduct detailed assessment feedback appointments both individually, and with a diagnostic team to ensure patients and/or families understand reports and recommendations.
- Counsel and provide ongoing treatment for families whose children are affected with autism, developmental disabilities, ADHD, etc. that includes supports that are **behaviorally** based.
- Collaborate and function as a vital part of a multi-disciplinary team.
- Provide leadership in a multi-disciplinary team, including educators, staff, parents and other professionals to accomplish assessment and treatment goals.
