Mike Penn called the meeting to order at 7:45 pm. No quorum present.

**MINUTES:** Minutes from the July General meeting were accepted.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Suzanne Martin reported that we have \$352,143.59 in the Operating account; \$32,347.21 in the Special Tax account; for a total of \$384,490.80. Suzanne presented the Treasurer's Report.

**PRESIDENT'S REPORT:** Mike Penn reported that someone rode over our message board sign at the head of the community. We applied to the County to see if we can build a community center using our Special Tax dollars and the County said yes. We are just looking at the idea. The community center could be used for many activities. Mike took questions from the floor about the community center. Elections are coming in November for our seven board members. Her McMillan was supposed to attend our meeting but had a change of plans and can't join us. Mike Penn introduced Patrick Daly from the County Exec office in attendance at our meeting.

**ADMINISTRATIVE:** Jean Somers mentioned that *the Sea Breeze* can now be received by postal mail or by an emailed link directing residents to *the Sea Breeze* on our web site. Jean is reminding residents of the two ways to receive *the Sea Breeze*. It was suggested that when we email residents a reminder we add a hyperlink so that a resident can more conveniently sign up for an emailed link for our newsletter.

**HUSE DRIVE HOUSE:** Mike Penn introduced Sam Hewett and Gail Morton of Huse Drive. Sam and Gail gave an update to the audience on the sober house at 105 Huse Drive. An informational meeting was attended by residents of Huse Drive and County Executive Steve Schuh. In attendance were employees from the County Exce Office, the County Law Office, the County Health Office, and Councilman Chris Trumbauer. The meeting lasted over an hour and the Huse Drive residents listened intently and took a lot of notes. The Sober House on Huse Drive is advertised as "Cambridge House of Annapolis." The house is not regulated or licensed

and it operates under its own rules. The manager on site does not live there anymore. Residents of Huse Drive have installed cameras that have helped decline activity at the Sober House. The residents of Huse Drive are waiting to hear back from Steve Schuh's Office. A question was raised about security in our community. The resident would like to see more of a security presence in our community. Discussion followed.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 9:00 pm.
