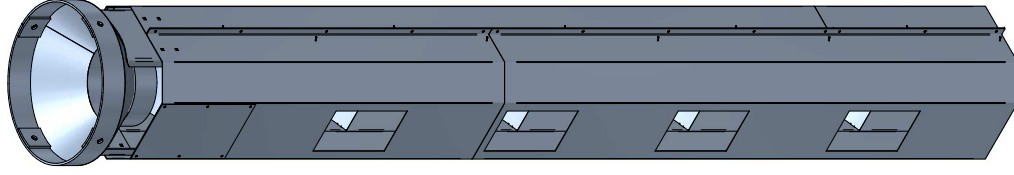


SECTION A-A



Note:

During bin filling, initially seed flows gently over a series of paddles

down and out of the bottom of the seed ladder to form a cone shaped pile.

Seed flows out the bottom of the seed ladder until the pile rises high enough to stop the flow.

At that point seed begins to flow out the lowest side opening of the seed ladder. The

rising pile stops that flow then seed flows out the next lowest opening on the opposite side of

the seed ladder. Seed flow alternates side to side progressively rising one paddle at a time

until the bin is full.
