This plan will reduce pollutants generated by burning of fossil fuels while encouraging the development of local renewable and sustainable energy generation plants.

This will keep energy generation dollars in our community and promote economic growth while helping reduce medical conditions such as cancer and heart disease caused by pollution.

### A Clean Energy Future

Working together with groups and government leaders from across the state, region and country, C.L.E.A.N. is helping develop plans that will have a strong positive impact on the future of our community, environment and economy.

### Regional energy study

We're spearheading a comprehensive regional energy study that we believe will show our community spends approximately half a billion dollars annually on energy. This not only sends money out of our community, but when petroleum prices increase, our economy suffers through increased transportation costs, higher heating and cooling bills, and reductions in consumer buying power.

### Transit systems improvement
