Ability Unlimited is proud to serve individuals enrolled in the CCC Plus Program through Virginia Medicaid and Medicaid waivers!

That means, the potential to facilitate getting you or your loved one the Assistive Technology they need!

As of August 1, 2017, we have assisted individuals who are enrolled in:

- the CCC Plus waiver (formerly the EDCD/Tech waivers),
- those under the age of 21 on the BI/CL/FIS waivers
- and individuals under 21 who have Medicaid and no waiver!

Am I Eligible?



This is not a grant - there are no applications for approval.

If the individual is enrolled in the CCC Plus Waiver, one of the DD Comprehensive waivers or if their CCC Plus Plan covers assistive technology or environmental modifications; they are eligible to request approval for services to be paid through Medicaid; ***provided medical necessity is determined by service authorization.***

The best way to determine eligibility and determine how to direct your request for services is

to complete our intake demographic form and return it to Ability Unlimited and we will contact you!

Bedtime Strategies for your Child with Special Needs

Bedtime. It can be difficult in the best of circumstances, but for parents of children with sensory issues, autism or ADHD, it can feel like a losing battle. But don't give up! There are

steps you can take to have a better time at bedtime.

Set the stage for sleep

Make your child's bedroom into a relaxing sanctuary. Turn off all electronics including TVs, smartphones, iPads and computers, keep lighting dim and use black-out shades. If your child insists on having light in her room, guide her to a nightlight. "Although it may be tempting to allow them the extra light to allay their concerns and fears of the dark, too much light is counterproductive to natural.

Access Devices


Portable Wheelchair Ramps

Ergonomically designed for easy toting, the Multi-Fold Reach Ramp can assist in getting up and down stairs, raised landings, vehicles - or all three! The ramp features an extended hook to clear any car's rear bumper and reflective straps for added safety. This two-fold ramp allows you to fold both its width and lengths in half as well as separate its lengths into two sections.

Additionally, the model can accommodate one or two axles. Comes in lengths from 6 to 10 foot; 30 inches wide; with a weight capacity of 800 pounds.



Cost if you had to pay for this device it can be, \$1000.00 and up (depending on combination of accessories). Ability Unlimited may be able to get you this device through Medicaid.
