In 1908 The Florida United Methodist Children's Home was established in Enterprise, Florida as the Florida Methodist Orphanage. It began with the purchase of one building, eight town lots and a tract of forty acres of land purchased from Miss Emma Tucker for \$1,250 dollars. Articles of Incorporation were filed with the State of Florida on June 3, 1908. Throughout its long and valued history, the Florida United Methodist Children's Home has been a haven of peace and a merciful blessing to all that have come into her care.
