It was written for the poor as medicine was extremely hard to come by in 18<sup>th</sup> century England. He put together a book that not only gave simple solutions with herbs that people could easily get, but he also focused on preventive care and how to take care of yourself before you get sick. For John Wesley and Methodists today, getting into the word is extremely important but one also needs to be living what the Bible talks about. This morning we will be looking at the ways John and the early Methodist Movement lived out the Biblical teachings.
