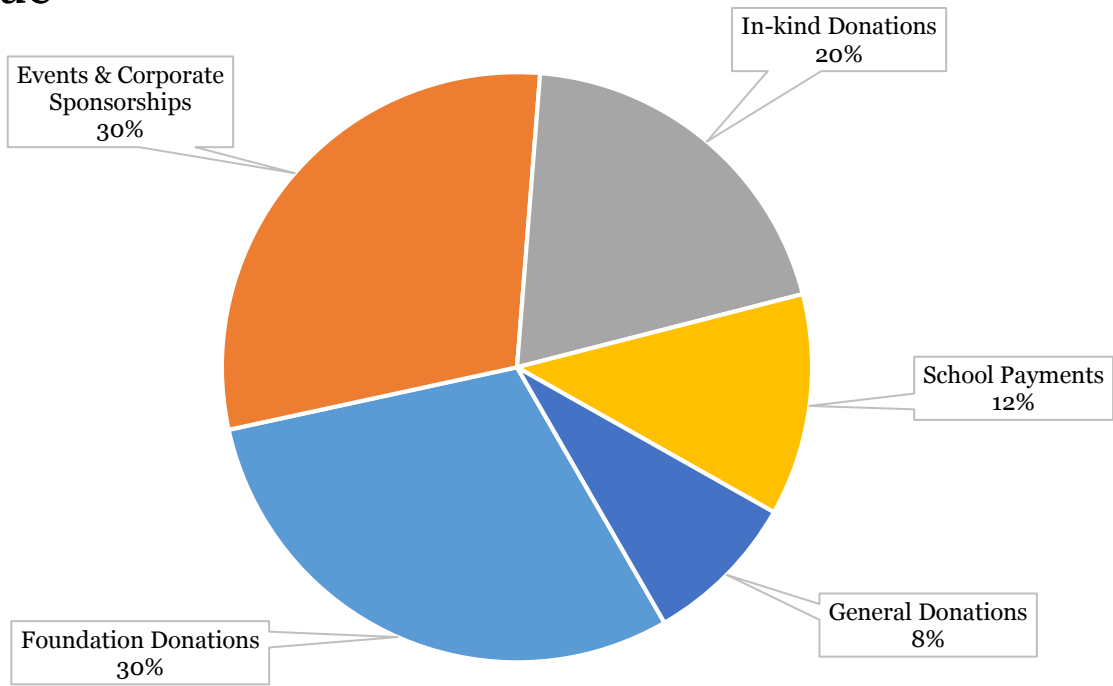

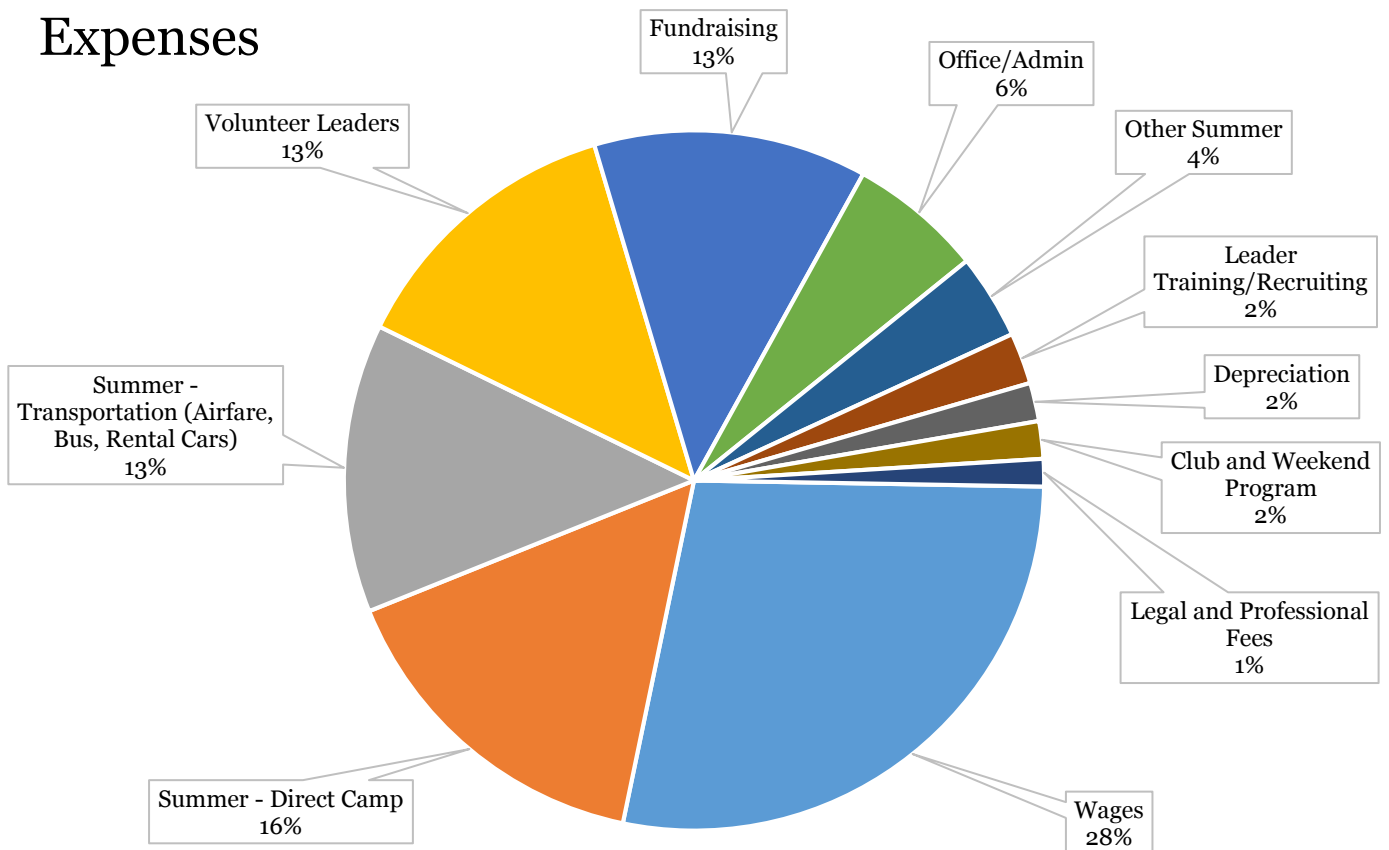

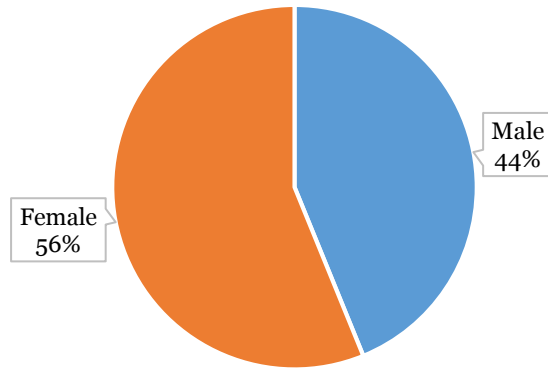

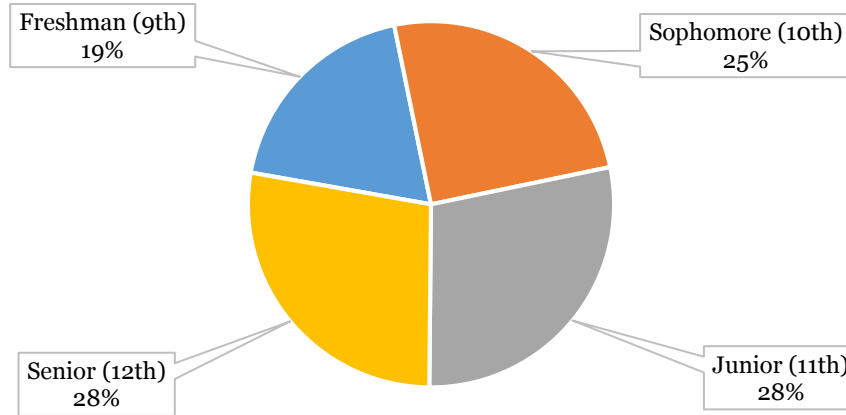
Expenses
