*Official Rounds November 23<sup>rd</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup>*

## **REGISTRATION**

- Entry Fee of \$20 for Youth Divisions, \$40 for Adult, \$75 for Money Class
- Registration available online or by mail in. Walk-ins permitted if space is available up to 30 minutes before start of shooting line.
- Please arrive 30 minutes prior to shooting line.

    - Saturday November 24<sup>th</sup> 9am, 1pm, 5pm
    - Sunday November 25<sup>th</sup> 10am, 2pm
- Registration is limited to a single Winter Classic event category.

- Barebow and Bow hunter divisions are separated into two classes. Youth Age 17 and under, and Adult age 18+)

- Bowhunter is a fixed pins with no magnification. Front stabilizer only less than 12" No adjusting pins after scoring has begun.
- Masters 50+ must be 50 years old by 12/31/2018.
- All divisions are **genderless**
- All divisions will use a 40cm face.
- Open Class features an 100% payback. Pay positions determined by field size. Guarantee Payout for top 3 of \$500 for 1<sup>st</sup>, \$300 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, \$200 for 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- Individual Payouts over \$600 must have W-9 IRS form

## SCORING

- All events will use Lancaster Style scoring with the X scoring as 11 for qualifying rounds. Best possible score 660.
- Qualification rounds for Main event will be shot on either a 40cm Vegas style 3 spot or single 40cm face.
- All rounds will be timed 2 minutes (120 seconds) for 3 arrows.
- Shots after the buzzer will result in highest scoring arrow to be scored as a miss.
- Double scoring on paper score card and electronic tablet.
- Arrow line calls made by group majority.
- Archer can request a judge if he/she disagrees with group call; only one judge may be called. Ruling is final.
- Do not touch any arrow before scoring is completed.
- Ties are based on score, # of 11's, 10's etc will be first tie breaker. Most consecutive rounds of 33 will be second tie breaker.
- Witnessed bounce outs or witnessed interference by another archer will be re-shot.
- Arrows crossing the dead arrow line score as shot arrows and cannot be reshot.
- Archer may miss up to two rounds during qualification round for equipment failure. Arrows will be made up at the end of round.
- Each qualification round will have two practice rounds in main event.

## Additional Details

- **Awards for Winter Classic will begin approximately at 6pm on Sunday.**
- **Awards will be sent with member of home club or mailed by December 1<sup>st</sup> for anyone not present**
- **Space is limited 360 participants shooting at 18m and 96 yeoman participants.**
