STEM Santa Fe Opens Registration for 2018 Julia Robinson Mathematics Festival

STEM Santa Fe is pleased to announce the 2018 Santa Fe Julia Robinson Mathematics Festival to be held on Friday, February 23, 2018 at the Santa Fe Community College. Teachers of 7th and 8th grades are invited to bring their students to this exciting math experience. The event will include mathematical puzzles and games, in addition to a tour of the sustainable technologies on the SFCC campus as well as a workshop with SOS (Science on Sphere). The event will run from 9:30am to 1:30pm and will include lunch. More information and registration signup is available at www.stemsantafe.org.

The festival honors the memory of Julia Robinson, a mathematics professor at University of California, Berkeley, for many years. She is recognized for her work in solving Hilbert's tenth problem. The Julia Robinson Mathematics Festivals began in the San Francisco Bay Area in 2007 to honor her legacy and encourage more students to pursue mathematics, and have since expanded to other cities around the world.
