



# LEWIS SHOOT RULES

1. When shooting has been completed, scores are listed in numerical order from the highest to the lowest.
2. Where a short class is necessary, due to odd entry list, the short class or classes shall head the list.  
Example:
  - 41 Entries in 3 Lewis Classes division is 13 – 14 – 14
  - 53 Entries in 3 Lewis Classes division is 17 – 18 – 18
3. Where the line of division falls in a number of tie scores, the contestants are assigned to the class in which the majority of the scores appear.  
Example:
  - More above the line: scores move up – next score becomes head of the winning class
  - More below the line: scores move down – that score becomes the head of the winning class
4. Where an equal number of tie scores appear on either side of the line, contestants shall be assigned to the head of the lower class.  
Example:
  - Four scores above the line and four scores below the line
  - All scores above the line move below the line and that number is head of the winning class
5. Where the original division is changed, due to tie scores, this change applies only to the classes affected, and the original division shall continue in the other classes.
