Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Waverly School District is committed to the ongoing education and safety of all our students. For this reason, we have decided to provide alternative learning in the event of school closures due to the health crisis. Over the past few days, the administration team, along with the teaching staff, has developed an at home learning plan to provide academic continuity through at-home learning activities accessible with or without the use of technology. In order to be prepared for this rapidly changing event, we are sending home two weeks of school work for our grade school students. Junior high and high school students are being informed of the expectations and instructions for at home learning in each of their classes today. Students will be expected to keep up with their work during this time. Teachers will be available to answer emails from students and parents between 9:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. Correspondence will be by email only.

Food distribution centers have been set up in three locations. Students qualifying for free/reduced lunch can pick up breakfast and lunch meals daily, Monday through Friday during the school closure. Students and/or parents can pick up their meals using the following information.

- Last names ending in A-G will go to City Hall at 9:00 a.m.
- Last names ending in H-M will go to the Fire Station at 10:00 a.m.
- Last names ending in N-Z will go to the First Baptist Church at 11:00 a.m.

Students that have medical supplies or medicine stored at the school will have the opportunity to pick up these items. The information for this pick up will be sent out through school messenger and/or school Facebook pages.

Students and parents are asked to stay away from all school facilities including the school playground and track/athletic fields. In the event of school closure, all activities that are housed at the school district facilities will also be cancelled. In addition, all extra-curricular activities will be suspended until school resumes.

In conclusion, it is our commitment to always keep our students safe and healthy, while providing a 21st century education. All decisions will be made based on consultation and recommendations from our health department and/or state. Unfortunately, regulations and information is changing by the hour, we will do our very best to be transparent via school reach, Facebook, and our website.
