TUCSON, AZ (Tucson News Now) - Arizona's three universities rank among [Bestcolleges.com](#)'s top 30 schools for LGBT students, in no particular order.

The survey highlights which colleges raise awareness of LGBT issues through clubs and other organizations.

The survey recognized the University of Arizona for its LGBTQ Affairs campus office, education workshops, support groups and its Institute for LGBT Studies. The university posted a [list](#) on Monday of events being hosted on campus for National Coming Out week through Friday.

Similarly, ASU has about 10 student organizations and offers an LGBT undergraduate certificate. NAU offers a Queer Studies minor and has an LGBTQA Resource and Support group that collaborates with other campus organizations.

The three Arizona universities also have at least one Greek life chapter.
