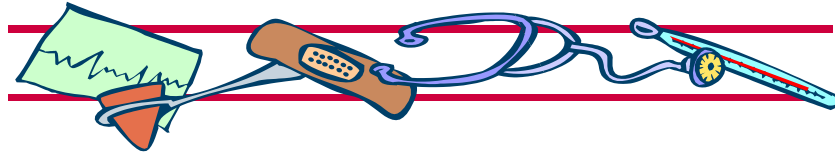

*MedlinePLUS* (<http://www.nlm.nih.gov/medlineplus/>) “*MedlinePlus* will direct you to information to help answer health questions. *MedlinePlus* brings together authoritative information from NLM, the National Institutes of Health (NIH), and other government agencies and health-related organizations. Preformulated MEDLINE searches are included in *MedlinePlus* and give easy access to medical journal articles. *MedlinePlus* also has extensive information about drugs, an illustrated medical encyclopedia, interactive patient tutorials, and the latest health news.”

*National Institute of Nursing Research* (<http://nintr.nih.gov>) “This organization’s mission is to support research in nursing in clinical and community settings. It provides links to nursing organizations for various specialties and publications from national conferences and meetings.”

*Pubmed Central* (<http://www.pubmedcentral.nih.gov/>) “A free digital archive of life sciences journal literature, including access to the full text of more than 160 journals.”

*Center for Disease Control* (<http://www.cdc.gov>) A website promoting information on specific health and safety topics, a public image database, and national data sets on health and disease.
