

AN ORDINANCE BY THE ROCKDALE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO AMEND SECTION 98-39, DIVISION 1 OF ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 98 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF ROCKDALE COUNTY, GEORGIA, ENTITLED "LANDLORD'S WATER LIABILITY", REGARDING THE ROCKDALE COUNTY WATER AND WASTEWATER SYSTEM; TO REPEAL ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS THE ROCKDALE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS, the Board of Commissioners manages and operates the Rockdale County Water and Wastewater System and is authorized pursuant to Chapter 98 of the Code of Rockdale County, Georgia to regulate water and wastewater use within Rockdale County, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, following a review of those regulations, the Board of Commissioners finds that the following amendment is appropriate in order to advance the public health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF ROCKDALE COUNTY, GEORGIA HEREBY ORDAINS that Chapter 98 Utilities, Section 98-39: Landlord's Water Liability, be amended, as follows:

Section 1.

Chapter 98 Utilities, Section 98-39: Landlord's Water Liability, of the Rockdale County Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed in its entirety and replaced with a new Section 98-39: Landlord's Water and Wastewater Liability, and shall read in full as follows:

The county shall not hold responsible any owner or landlord for indebtedness of a prior owner, prior occupant, or prior lessee. The county shall hold responsible and seek reimbursement for unpaid charges only from the person who incurred the charges. The county shall not impose a lien against real property to secure unpaid charges for water or wastewater service unless the owner of such real property is the person who incurred the charges.

The County shall hold Landlords responsible for repairing water leaks, prior to a Tenant's move-in, and applying for service instead of Tenant until leak is confirmed repaired. After water or wastewater leak repair is confirmed and Landlord has paid final water/wastewater bill, said Tenant can then apply for establishment of water/wastewater service.

Section 2. Repeal of All Ordinances in Conflict

All ordinances or resolutions or portions thereof in conflict with this ordinance are repealed to the extent of their conflict.

Section 3. Severability.

If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance, and such remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date
