



## Wild Aware Utah Activity

### Utah Wildlife PUZZLE

**Cougars:** are members of the cat family, *Felidae*. Cougars are tawny brown or reddish brown in color, with a white muzzle, black tipped ears and tail. They are also called mountain lions, panthers, pumas or catamounts.

**Coyotes:** are members of the dog family, *Canidae*. Coyotes are brownish-gray to reddish brown. Vocalizations include loud yipping and short bark-howls.

**Black bears:** are members of the bear family *Ursidae*. They can be black, brown or cinnamon color. Their muzzles have shorter, paler colored hair. The black bear is the only bear species found in Utah.

#### What you need:

- stiff cardboard
- crayons or colored pencils
- glue
- scissors
- cougar, coyote or bear puzzle pattern

#### What you do:

1. Color the animal puzzle pattern.
2. Glue the colored animal picture onto a piece of stiff cardboard. Set aside to dry.
3. Draw a grid of lines on the back of the cardboard to make 12 equal-sized rectangles. Cut along the lines to make the puzzle pieces.
4. Put the pieces together to make the Utah animal picture.
