# Instructor Course Instructor Nomination

The ARC Instructor Course facilitates the candidate to use the knowledge and skills required to:

- discuss the nature of teaching and learning using memory theory
- identify the needs and motivations of individual learners
- deliver effective structured education to candidates who may display a variety of attributes and skill levels in a timely manner
- demonstrate effective educational delivery in scenario teaching, skills teaching and leading discussion groups
- state attributes that contribute towards valid and reliable assessment
- demonstrate the delivery of an effective candidate assessment

Instructor Course Instructors are drawn from experienced Australian Resuscitation Council Advanced Life Support Instructors. The criteria for nomination is:

- Must be an ARC ALS2 Instructor for the Hybrid course and current in certification
- Must be an ARC registered Course Director or eligible to apply for ARC ALS Course Director status
- Essential Full ALS2 Instructor for 4 courses. Preferable - exposure to ALS1 Instructing
- Instructed at more than one course centre in last 2 years
- Demonstrates ability to give succinct feedback with integrity to candidates
- Demonstrated mentorship of Instructor Candidates
- Demonstrates engaging communication skills to interprofessional groups
- In depth knowledge of the clinical core material and ability to relate this accurately

**Instructor Course Instructor Currency**

- Instructor Course Instructors are certificated as such for three years from the date of the most recent course
- Instructor Course faculty need to teach on 3 courses every 2 years to be deemed current
- One Instructor course must be at an external site to that of their 'home' centre and ideally include interstate courses
- If no instruction completed on an Instructor Course for more than 3 years the Instructor must be nominated to regain Instructor Course Instructor status
- Is willing to mentor Instructor Candidates on provider courses where specific recommendations have been made during instructor courses
- Instructor Course faculty are recertified at every three years (or more frequently if required) by faculty review during instruction on an Instructor Course
- Preferable – willing to travel to interstate courses
