Formal Dining Area:

Traditional Business Casual Attire may be worn in the dining room for Sunday Brunch
Traditional Business Casual Attire may be worn in the formal dining area after 5:00 pm.
Traditional Business Attire and Formal Attire is always welcome in the dining area.

All other areas of the building:

Casual Attire is permissible in the Bar area and all areas other than the formal dining and ballroom unless stated otherwise.

Members, Residents and Patron responsibility in regards to guests:

We request you inform your guests of the dress requirements. If you book a party or special event, we request you convey the dress code associated with the event to your guests.

Definitions:

Business Casual Attire Includes:

Men:

Tailored slacks, sweaters, collared shirts, walking shorts and appropriate footwear are considered acceptable.

Women:

Tailored slacks or skirt, sweaters, blouses, walking shorts and appropriate footwear are considered acceptable.

Casual Attire Includes:

Men:

Walking shorts and shirts with collars are acceptable. Jeans or any denim material is acceptable unless visibly worn, faded or torn (intentional or unintentional.) Sneakers and caps are permitted.

Women:

Walking shorts, skirts, knit shirts, sleeveless shirts and shirts with collars are acceptable. Jeans or any denim material is acceptable unless visibly worn, faded or torn (intentional or unintentional). Sneakers and caps are permitted.

Prohibited Attire Includes:

Gym shorts, tank tops, under shirts, T-shirts, flip-flops
