90 Points - The 1997 Late Harvest Zinfandel has a jammy, perfumed bouquet of ripe plums, ripe cherries, blackberries, cassis, cola, pepper and violets with a hint of candy apple. The flavors of briar berries, cherries, cassis, chocolate, pepper and cinnamon are lush and expansive followed by a long, lingering, fruity, non-cloying finish. Delicious.

87 Points - This is what happens when Zin gets overripe. Alcohol is 15.5% and residual sugar is 3.0%. The result is a Port-like wine that's huge in extract and sweet on the tongue. A hot finish. An only-in-California wine that can find a place on the table if paired with the right foods.

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
