**Thursday, Nov 29, 11:00 AM - Urban Ride - Burnt Mill-Curtain Pole Road** - Leave from the Tennessee Riverpark at Curtain Pole Road at 11:00. This park is along the Riverwalk off Amnicola Highway. It is south of the Riverpark Fry Center and north of Boathouse Restaurant. There is a Mapco directly across Amnicola at the turn for Curtain Pole Road. This fun urban ride starts and finishes on the Riverwalk, and it includes an old club favorite – Burnt Mill Road, and a ride through the city! 30 miles, 11-13 mph, no drop. **Friday, Nov 30, 10:30 AM - Riverpark Twenty or Thirty Mile Leisure Ride** - This ride consists of two loops. The first loop is a leisurely ride that follows the Riverwalk from the Hubert Fry Center to the Wheland Foundry Station in St. Elmo, and then returns to Hubert Fry Center. The ride has a “bring your own snack” stop at the Blue Goose Hollow Station on the way back from St. Elmo. Near the end of the loop, riders have the option of either heading back to Hubert Fry Center, or adding the second loop, a ten mile ride that follows the South Chickamauga Creek Greenway. 20 or 30 miles (Rider choice!), 9-10 mph, no drop. The average speed for the second loop will be a bit higher!
