## CBC General Membership Meeting Minutes June 17, 2019 Outdoor Chattanooga

- Meeting called to order at 6:03 pm.
- Presiding: Joe Ladato, President

Approval of May Meeting Minutes – Motion: Ben, seconded: Joe. Vote: Approved.

**President**- Joe Lodato

Status of promotional items – Joe stated that the patch kits (250) and tire levers (250) were ordered online at a reasonable price. Unfortunately, the emails to authorize the order were in his spam and the order did not make it in time for the Bluegrass festival. They are ready for giveaways at future events. He investigated ProPatch.com for stickers but determined they were cost prohibitive. Other giveaway items he is collecting to give away are water bottles, and socks. Theses can be used in the grab bags at the Cycle Sequatchie event. Discussion about pint glasses, reusable cups or metal cups as giveaways at Cycle Sequatchie. Action: Joe will talk with Shannon about the cup idea.

## Cycle Sequatchie – Volunteer email & updates

There was discussion about getting more people to volunteer for the event. Beverly suggested having list of jobs and time slots in an email to members and in the Tailwind. At the last meeting Shannon stated that he only needed 30 volunteers. At the last meeting, Shannon stated that volunteers were really needed at rest stops and as course marshals. Shannon stated there will be 5 rest stops

There were several discussions on how to sign up to volunteer. Michelle informed the group that Shannon has set up <u>an online volunteer sign-up form</u>. This online volunteer website is SignUp.com. She showed the group the email she received after volunteering from the SignUp.com website. Daisy asked if the link was on Tailwind. *Action: Michelle will send link to Daisy and Rich*.

David recommended calling people to volunteer for Cycle Sequatchie. Ben stated that at his next CBC Ride (Thursday night A group) that we will tell them about Cycle Sequatchie, distribute flyers and encourage attendees to either ride or volunteer.

## Vice President – Ben Keim

**CBC Stickers update** – Ben stated that he has contacted Lou but has not heard from him. Ben stated that he wanted to order 300 stickers. He thought Lou talked to someone about vinyl stickers for windows and bike racks. He stated that Kat is including the stickers in her packets for bike lights (500) and bike safety pamphlets. The packets will be distributed by Police Departments, Outdoor Chattanooga staff at events, and ride leaders.

Daisy stated that CBC brochures need to be all bicycle shops and on display at Outdoor Chattanooga. Rich stated that Tony reprinted the last brochures at the Chattanooga State event and that he may have the

latest version. *Action: Ben will contact Tony about the brochures*. Several members stated that Lou has the brochure electronically and that he printed it.
