6. LIMITATION

Pursuant to application and subject to applicable law and regulations and to the conditions set forth below, you are hereby authorized to engage, at the above address, in the operations specified herein. This permit is continuing, and will remain in force until suspended, revoked, voluntarily surrendered, or automatically terminated.

This permit is not transferable. In the event of any lease, sale, or other transfer of the operations authorized, or any other changes in the proprietor of such operations, this permit shall automatically terminate.

If the permittee is a corporation, in the event there is a change in its actual or legal control, directly or indirectly, whether through stock ownership or control (in the permittee corporation or in any other corporation), by operation of law, or in any other manner, the permit shall automatically terminate unless, within 10 days of such change, the permittee shall give written notice thereof, executed under the penalties of perjury, to the Director, National Revenue Center, Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau, 550 Main St, Ste 8002, Cincinnati, OH 45202-5215 (1-877-882-3277); or if the business is located in Puerto Rico, to the District Director (Investigations) Puerto Rico Operations, Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau, Ste 310, Torre Chardon, 350 Carlos Chardon Ave, San Juan, PR 00918-2124.

If the notice is timely submitted, the permit will remain in effect until the expiration of 30 days after such change, whereupon it shall automatically terminate unless within such 30-day period a proper application for a new permit is made, in which event it shall continue in effect until final action is taken on such application, at which time it shall automatically terminate.

If the permittee is a partnership, this permit shall automatically terminate on the death or insolvency of a partner, unless located in a State

where a surviving partner has the legal right to the control and possession of partnership assets for purposes of liquidation or settlement, in which event this permit will remain in effect, provided the required consent of surety on the bond is obtained and filed with the National Revenue Center or Puerto Rico Operations Office, until the completion of such liquidation or settlement by the surviving partner or partners at which time it shall automatically terminate.

CONDITIONS

This permit is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the permittee in good faith complies with the provisions of Chapter 51 of Title 26 of the United States Code and regulations issued thereunder.
2. That the permittee has made no false statements as to any material fact in his application for this permit.
3. That the permittee discloses all the material information required by law and regulation.
4. That the permittee shall not violate or conspire to violate any law of the United States relating to intoxicating liquor and shall not be convicted of any offense under the United States Code punishable as a felony or of any conspiracy to commit such an offense.
5. That all persons employed by the permittee in good faith observe and conform to all of the terms and conditions of this permit.
6. That the permittee does not discontinue the operations authorized by this permit for a period of more than 2 year.
