## Middle School/ High School

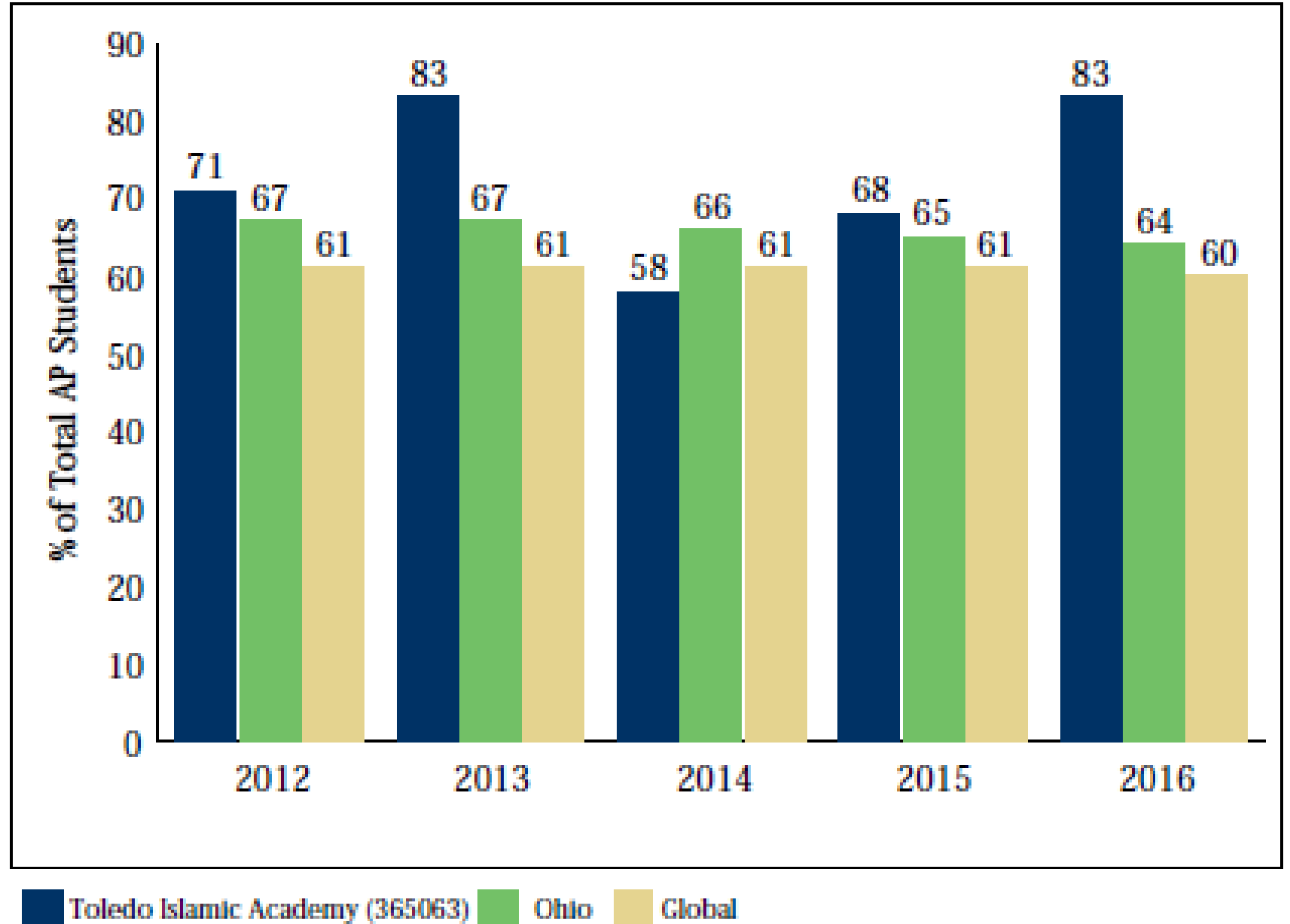
- Use of Chromebook or iPad in classes

- Continue to hire qualified and dedicated teachers

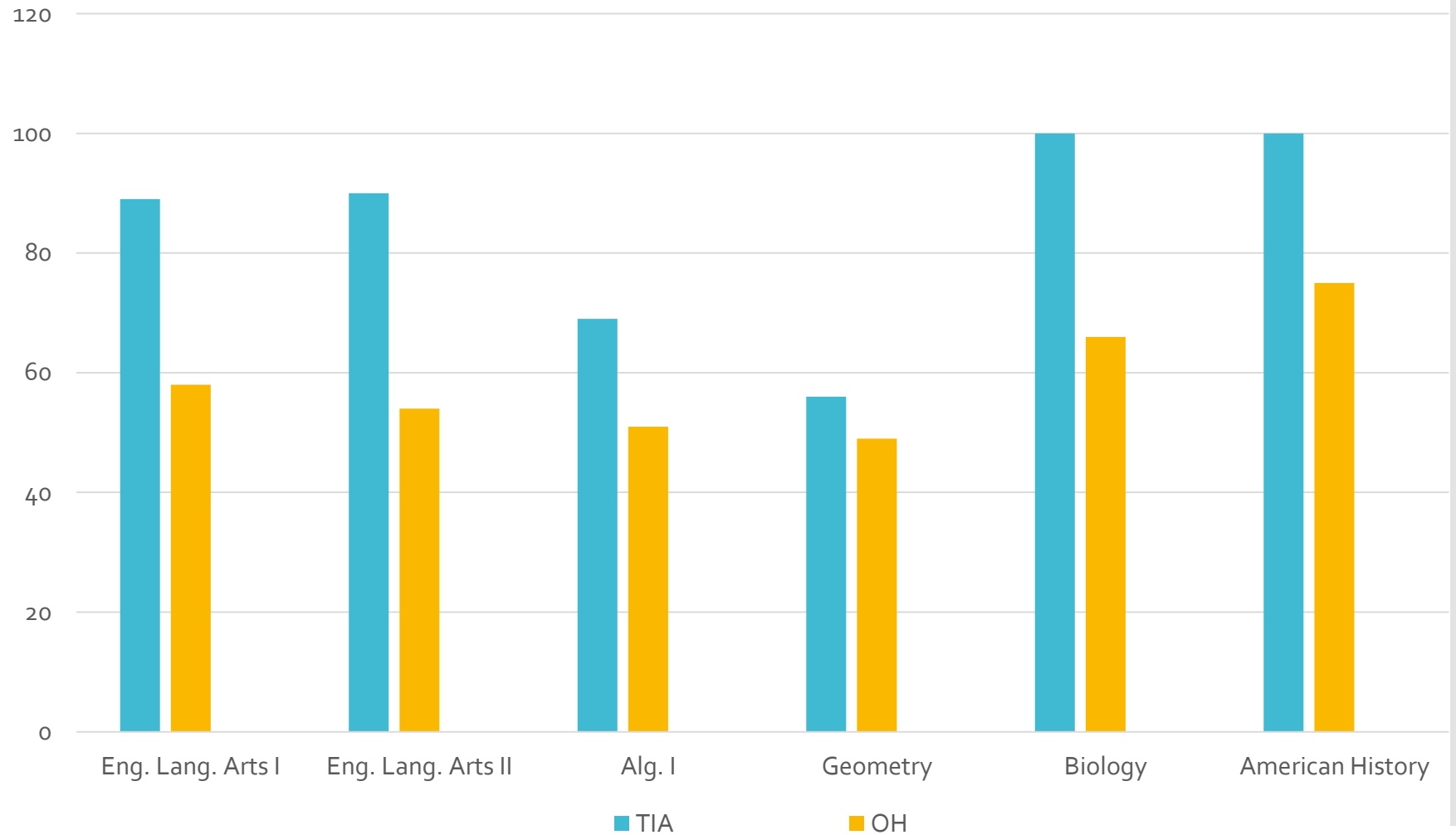
# Advanced Placement Exam Results

% of Total AP Students with Scores 3+



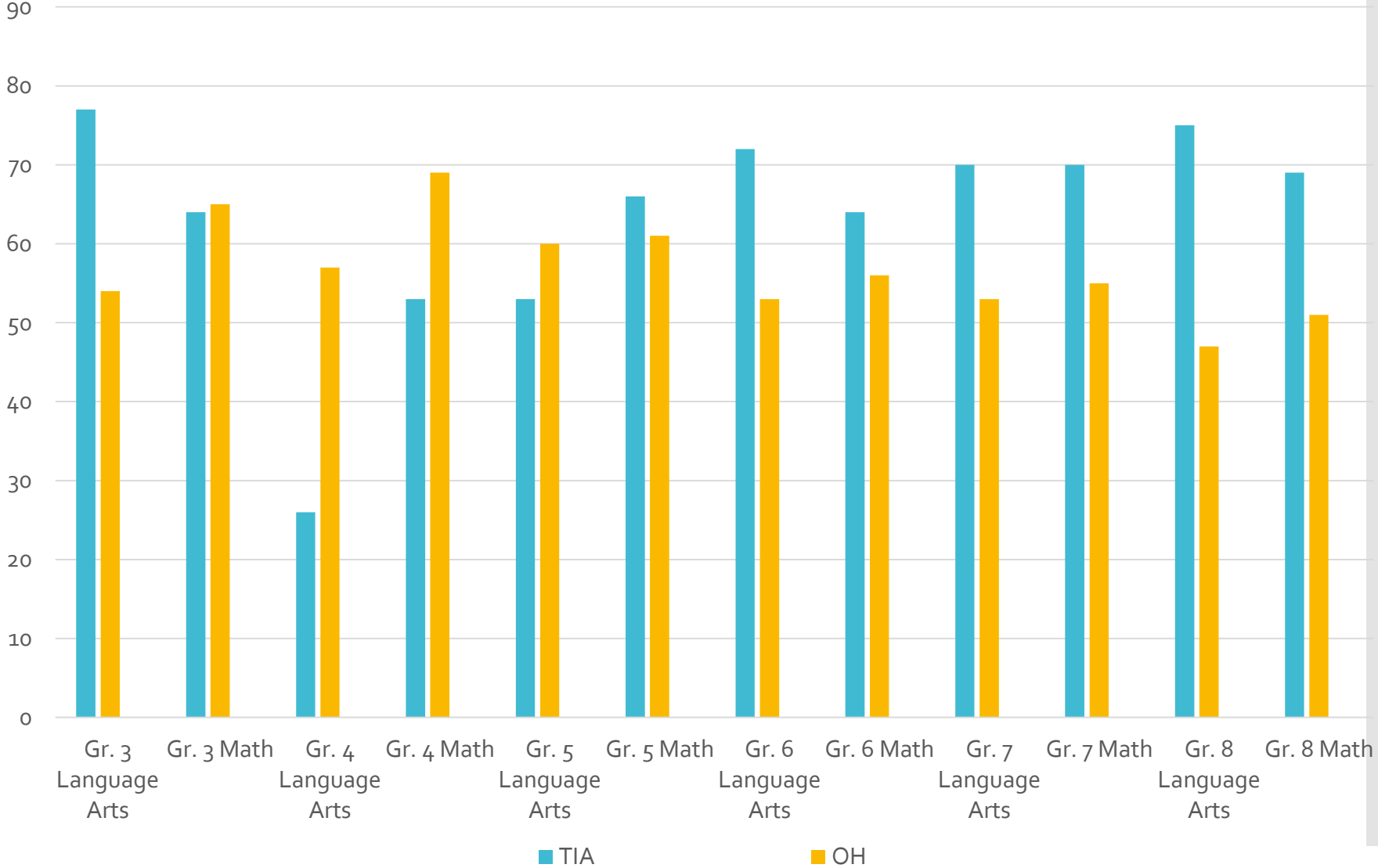
# High School State End of Course Results

Spring 2016


