

**Final Minutes of the Dallesport/Murdock Community Council
July 12, 2012**

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

Roll Call was taken with 7 out of the 9 council members present. Anthony Rizzi was excused and Chris Murray resigned. There were 17 people in the audience.

Speaker: Klickitat County Chief Criminal Deputy Pat Kaley spoke about the increase in burglaries and vandalism in our area. The audience then asked questions. Deputy Pat reported 3 vehicle prowls, 16 thefts, 8 burglaries, no assaults, 5 prowlers, 6 criminal mischief since March 1, 2012. Most crimes were late night or early morning. A curfew cannot be done in Washington—it's unconstitutional in this state. Brochures and info on the web about setting up a Community Watch if we want.
